The ALLNE EDoL writing competition celebrated its 13th. year of engaging language learners in schools in using their languages for creative purposes!

This year's competition was affected by the Recovery Curriculum issues created by the COVID-19 pandemic, and many of the entries on the theme 'Time capsule' included items relating to the pandemic in their texts . As ever judges enjoyed reading texts written creatively by language learners from Primary up to Sixth Form in a variety of styles, often beautifully presented, ranging from the personal to the poetic, contriversial and philosophical. Numbers of entries were up on last year, with new schools participating, and several schools were commended by certificate for the quantity / quality of their collective contribution.

We are once again very grateful to our sponsors, and to the Newcastle University Language Centre for support in reading scripts from a range of Home / Heritage / Community Languages.

The organisers felt that **all schools** who participated deserved recognition of their work to maintain the profile of language learning and encourage their learners to express themselves creatively, often going beyond the limits of typical coursework. All received a message from the Judges.
