AM I ELIGIBLE?

To be eligible to apply, you must have one of the following in French, German or Spanish:

- a 2:1, or predicted 2:1
- · a relevant PhD or Master's degree, or recognised equivalent.

We may also consider your application if you have a degree in another subject, or a 2.2 (or predicted 2.2) if you are able to demonstrate significant knowledge in the target language.

You must also have secured a place on an eligible non-salaried languages teacher training scheme in England for the 2017/18 academic year by September 2017. And you must meet the student finance criteria (https://www.gov.uk/student-finance/who-qualifies), Your chosen teacher training provider will be able to advise you on this if you are unsure.
